PRODUCTION LINKED INCENTIVE (PLI) SCHEME AND EMPLOYMENT

A meaningful change in India's industrial policy, the Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) schemes are the latest additions to the game-changing reforms that have been introduced under the aegis of the 'AatmaNirbhar Bharat Abhiyan' (Self-Reliant India movement) launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

The idea behind the scheme is to offer companies incentives on incremental sales from products manufactured in India, over the base year. The scheme also invites foreign companies to set up units in India alongside encouraging local companies to set up or expand existing manufacturing units, generate more employment and cut down the country's reliance on imports. It will also have beneficial spill-over effects via the creation of a big supplier base for the anchor units established under the scheme.

In the Union Budget 2021-22, the Finance Minister announced an outlay of



Rs. 1.97 lakh crore (~USD 26 Bn) for the PLI schemes for 13 key sectors which have been shortlisted on the basis of their potential for revenue and employment generation. The scheme also intends to generate large-scale employment by incentivising the development of

traditional, labour-intensive sectors such as food processing and textiles.

Covering key employment generating sectors of ESDM, automobiles, pharmaceuticals, telecommunications, textiles, food products, renewable energy, white goods and steel, the scheme

envisages to provide an average 5% of the production value as an incentive. This implies that the minimum production in the country as an outcome of the PLI schemes stands to be around Rs. 3.92 lakh crore (~USD 500 Bn) in the next five years, as per reports by NITI Aayog.

This massive boost in production has the potential to create nearly 1.40 crore man-months' worth of jobs directly from 2021-22, which translates to effectively doubling the existing workforce across sectors. With the inclusion of the suppliers and vendors of the manufacturing companies benefitting from the PLI scheme, a total of 4.20 crore man-months of jobs are set to be generated, as per the data by Indian Staffing Federation.

While making domestic manufacturing globally competitive, boosting exports and creating global champions across strategic sectors, the biggest takeaway of the scheme lies in its potential to generate

SDG INDIA INDEX 3.0: MEANING AND SIGNIFICANCE

NITI Aayog has released the third edition of the SDG India Index. The report titled *SDG India Index and Dashboard 2020-21: Partnerships in the Decade of Action*, designed and developed by the Aayog, focuses on the significance of partnerships as its theme. NITI Aayog has the twin mandate to oversee the adoption and monitoring of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in the country, and also promote competitive and cooperative federalism among States and Union Territories.

What is SDG India Index?

The SDG India Index is an aggregate measure which can be understood and used by everyone—policymakers, businesses, civil society and the general public. It has been designed to provide an aggregate assessment of the performance of all Indian States and UTs, and to help leaders and changemakers evaluate their performance on social,

economic and environmental parameters. The Index represents the articulation of the comprehensive nature of the Global Goals under the 2030 Agenda while being attuned to the national priorities. The modular nature of the Index has become a policy tool and a ready reckoner for

progress on the SDGs in the country and has simultaneously fostered a healthy competition among the States and UTs. SDG India Index 2020-21 spans across 16 out of 17 SDGs (with a qualitative assessment on Goal 17). The Index tracks the progress of all the States and UTs on

highlights data gaps in the statistical system of the States/UTs and identify the sectors in which robust and more frequent data needs to be collected.

What is the methodology?

Designed and developed by NITI Aayog, the preparation of the Index follows extensive consultations with the primary stakeholders—the States and Union Territories, the UN agencies led by United Nations in India, Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI) and the key Union Ministries.

The SDG India Index computes goal-wise scores on the 16 SDGs for each State and Union Territory. Overall State and UT scores are generated from goal-wise scores to measure aggregate performance of the sub-national unit based on its performance across the 16 SDGs. These scores range between 0-100, and if a State/UT achieves a score of 100, it signifies it has achieved the 2030 targets. The higher the score of a State/UT, the greater the distance to target

gauging progress of States and UTs on the expansive nature of the Goals, including health, education, gender, economic growth, institutions, climate change and environment.

Since its inaugural launch in 2018, the SDG index has been comprehensively documenting and ranking the progress made by States and UTs towards achieving the Sustainable Development Goals. Now in its third year, the Index has become the primary tool for monitoring

a set of 115 National Indicators, measuring their progress on the outcomes of the interventions and schemes of the Government of India.

The SDG India Index is intended to provide a holistic view on the social, economic and environmental status of the country and its States and UTs. It enables the States/UTs to learn from the good practices of their peers and supports them in identifying priority areas which demand more attention. The Index also

employment. Even while defining each sector's expected outcomes, employment shares the stage with parameters like increase in investment, production and exports.

The most exemplary example of the PLI scheme's success in transforming the domestic manufacturing landscape of a specific sector can be seen in the large-scale electronics manufacturing domain, where, within a few months of the scheme's launch, the 16 approved companies produced goods worth nearly Rs. 35,000 crore, invested nearly Rs. 1,300 crore and are set to create around 22,000 jobs, under the scheme.

At the outset of the PLI schemes, mobile manufacturing and specified electronic components has pegged its expected direct employment of nearly 2 lakh and an additional indirect employment of nearly 3 times the direct employment in next five years. A similar major feat has been achieved by the medical devices sector, where 14 applications have been approved by the government with a total committed investment of Rs. 873.93 crore and expected employment generation of about 4,212 out of the larger goal of creating additional employment of 33,750 jobs over a period of five year.

The success of the PLI in large-scale manufacturing sets the perfect precedent for the pharmaceutical industry to witness similar growth and expand its domestic manufacturing capacities. For starting materials/drug intermediaries and active pharmaceutical ingredients, approvals

have been accorded to 16 applicants which have committed a total investment of Rs. 348.70 crore and employment generation of about 3,042 out of the proposed target of creating 12,140 overall jobs.

In November 2020, the Union Cabinet has given its approval to introduce the PLI Scheme in the 10 key sectors of Advance Chemistry Cell (ACC) Battery, Electronic/Technology Products, Automobiles & Auto Components, Pharmaceuticals drugs, Telecom & Networking Products, Textile Products, Food Products, High Efficiency Solar PV Modules, White Goods (Air Conditioners and LED Lights) and Specialty Steel.

As per government estimates, the PLI scheme is expected to yield employment creation, starting from the next financial year—1.80 lakh employment opportunities for manufacturing electronic/technology products, one lakh jobs for manufacturing pharmaceuticals drugs, 2.5 lakh persons for segments of food for which the PLI has been announced, four lakh direct and indirect employment opportunities for the white goods sector; and direct employment of about 30,000 and indirect employment of about 1.2 lakh persons in the entire solar PV manufacturing ecosystem.

As per the Indian Staffing Federation, 14,07,778 jobs will be created in Advance Chemistry Cell (ACC) Battery, 3,88,889 jobs in ESDM, 44,36,600 in manufacturing of automobiles and its components, 11,66,667 in production of pharmaceuticals drugs, 9,48,500 in

telecom and networking products, 8,30,900 for manufacturing textile and 8,47,778 for food products, 3,50,000 in solar PV modules, 4,85,178 in white goods (specifically air conditioners and LED Lights) and 4,91,711 jobs for manufacturing specialty steel. The grand total direct and collateral job surge expected has been pegged at 1,13,54,000 and 3,40,62,000 respectively, by the Indian Staffing Federation.

The PLI scheme is expected to have a cascading effect, having a lasting impact on MSMEs (Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises). Along with the anchor units, supplier units will also help generate massive primary and secondary employment opportunities. Moreover, the specific product lines identified in each of the 10 sectors is based on having high growth potential and capabilities to generate medium- to large-scale employment.

As the detailed guidelines of each sector under PLI are being released and a roadmap for its effective implementation being drawn, the coming five years will witness a sharp yet meaningful turn in its larger industrial policy. The new pro-growth template for India's industrial policy contains all essential parameters to make India a manufacturing hub and transform its huge population into productive workforce.

- (e) **Tattoo.** Permanent body tattoos are not permitted on any part of the body. 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





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



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Doctors: How to truly celebrate them?

COVID-19 pandemic has taken a significant toll on people all across the globe. In the time of this grave health crisis, doctors are working on the frontlines and rendering invaluable service to the nation. While most of us have the option of working safely from the confines of our homes, these medical professionals are putting their lives at risk and standing ground to save as many lives as possible. Their selfless determination is deserving of our respect, not only in spirit but also in our actions. In this challenging battle against COVID-19, let us do our bit—wear masks all the time, sanitise our hands, maintain social distancing, get vaccinated, but most importantly and fundamentally, keep ourselves updated with facts and away from rumours.

1. Myth: One cannot contract COVID-19 after vaccination.

Fact: Vaccination is crucial to prevent COVID-19. Vaccine will not allow the virus to further replicate and it will not allow the disease to become severe. However, during that time, your RT-PCR test can be positive and you may infect others. So, it is important to follow COVID-appropriate behaviour (wearing masks, regularly washing hands, maintain social distancing) even after vaccination. It must be noted that only 0.03-0.04% of the people have contracted COVID-19 after vaccination and even then, they have had mild symptoms.

2. Myth: Prolonged usage of masks leads to intoxication of CO₂ and oxygen deficiency in the body.

Fact: This claim is fake. Wearing mask is essential in preventing oneself from getting infected.

3. Myth: Smokers and vegetarians are less prone to COVID-19.

Fact: Presently, no conclusion can be drawn based on the serological studies that vegetarian diet and smoking may protect one from COVID-19.

4. Myth: 5G mobile networks help spread COVID-19.

Fact: Viruses cannot travel on radio waves/mobile networks. COVID-19 is spread through respiratory droplets when an infected person coughs, sneezes or speaks. People can also be infected by touching a contaminated surface and then their eyes, mouth or nose. Mobile towers emit non-ionizing radio frequencies having very minuscule power and are incapable of causing any kind of damage to living cells including human beings. Department of Telecommunications (DoT) has prescribed norms for exposure limit for the Radio Frequency Field (i.e., Base Station Emissions) which are 10 times more stringent than the safe limits prescribed by International Commission on Non-Ionizing Radiation Protection (ICNIRP) and recommended by



WHO. COVID-19 cases have been reported in countries that do not have 5G.

5. Myth: Coronavirus cannot spread in hot and humid climates.

Fact: One can contract COVID-19, no matter how hot or humid the climate is. Countries with hot weather have reported cases of COVID-19. To protect yourself, make sure you clean your hands frequently and thoroughly and avoid touching your eyes, mouth, and nose.

6. Myth: Climate change and rain can slowdown the pace of infection.

Fact: The spread of coronavirus can be reduced only by following COVID-appropriate behaviour.

7. Myth: Regularly rinsing your nose with saline helps prevent coronavirus infection.

Fact: There is no evidence that the said method has protected people from getting infected.

8. Myth: Eating garlic prevents COVID-19.

Fact: Garlic is a healthy food that may have some antimicrobial properties. However, there is no evidence from the current outbreak that eating garlic has protected people from the novel coronavirus.

9. Myth: Consuming betel leaves can help prevent COVID-19 and can cure an infected person too.

Fact: This claim is false. Coronavirus spread can be checked only by following COVID-appropriate behaviour.

10. Myth: Hospitalisation is necessary after testing positive for coronavirus.

Fact: Hospitalisation is not required in all cases. Asymptomatic and mild cases can be managed at home.

11. Myth: Remdesivir is a life-saving drug for COVID-19.

Fact: Remdesivir is an experimental drug for people who are moderately sick and are receiving oxygen. Studies do not show mortality reduction with Remdesivir. It must

not be used for patients who are not on oxygen support or in home settings.

12. Myth: COVID-19 vaccine can cause infertility in both men and women.

Fact: There is no scientific proof that the vaccine can cause infertility. It is completely safe.

13. Myth: People with one or more comorbidities should not get vaccinated.

Fact: People with comorbidities fall in the high-risk category and must get vaccinated. The vaccine is safe and effective in adults with comorbidity.

14. Myth: If one has COVID-19, they need not get vaccinated.

Fact: It is advisable to receive the complete schedule of the vaccine irrespective of past history of infection. One must get vaccinated three months after recovery from COVID-19.

15. Myth: Women should not take the vaccine five days before and after their menstrual cycle.

Fact: Experts have rubbished the claim and said that periods have no effect on the vaccine.

16. Myth: Antibodies develop right after getting vaccinated.

Fact: Protective level of antibodies generally develops two weeks after receiving the second dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

17. Myth: A person will remain protected only for six months after the vaccination.

Fact: Longevity of the immune response in vaccinated individuals is yet to be determined. Therefore, continuing the use of mask and sanitiser is strongly recommended.

18. Myth: Anaesthetics can be life-threatening for COVID-19 vaccinated people.

Fact: There is no scientific evidence till date to confirm the claim.

19. Myth: COVID-19 vaccines can make people magnetic.

Fact: COVID-19 vaccines do not make people magnetic. They do not contain any metal-based ingredients and are completely safe. Vaccines cannot cause a magnetic reaction in human body.

20. Myth: COVID-19-vaccinated arm generates electricity.

Fact: The COVID-19 vaccine does not cause the body to produce electric current.

21. Myth: Only one dose of COVISHIELD is sufficient.

Fact: In India, the COVISHIELD vaccination schedule consists of two doses. After 12 weeks of the first dose, it is necessary to take the second shot.

22. Myth: COVAXIN is not as safe as COVISHIELD vaccine.

Fact: Both COVISHIELD and COVAXIN were launched after multiple tests and trials. Both the vaccines are safe. The Hon'ble Prime Minister took the first dose of COVAXIN in March this year.

23. Myth: The final vaccine product of COVAXIN contains new-born calf serum.

Fact: New-born calf serum is used only for preparation/growth of Vero cells. Different kinds of bovine and other animal serum are standard enrichment ingredient used globally for Vero cell growth. Vero cells are used to establish cell lines which help in production of vaccines. This technique has been used for decades in Polio, Rabies, and Influenza vaccines. These Vero cells, after the growth, are washed with water and chemicals (also technically known as buffer) several times to make it free from the new-born calf serum. Thereafter, these Vero cells are infected with corona virus for viral growth. The Vero cells are completely destroyed in the process of viral growth. Thereafter, this grown virus is also killed (inactivated) and purified. This killed virus is then used to make the final vaccine, and in the final vaccine formulation no calf serum is used.

24. Myth: Mucormycosis (Black Fungus) can be treated with alum, turmeric, rock salt and mustard oil.

Fact: This claim is false. There is no scientific evidence to treat black fungus with this remedy. Please do not rely only on home remedies to treat any such serious health problem.

As India celebrates National Doctor's Day in July, let us thank doctors and physicians for their relentless service to the humanity. Let us join this battle by combating the misinformation with awareness. Let us be mindful of our actions and behaviour and take a pledge to help them help us.

achieved. Based on the score across all 16 SDGs, the States/UTs are classified into the four categories based on their distance from target—Aspirant (0-49), Performer (50-64), Front-Runner (65-99), and Achiever (100).

1. Selection of indicators

As the first step, suitable indicators from the National Indicator Framework (NIF) on SDGs are identified and mapped with the targets. Guided by the NIF, NITI Aayog has constructed a list of 115 indicators. To determine suitable metrics for inclusion in the Index, technically sound and quantitative criteria-based indicators are chosen that have:

- a) Relevance to the SDG targets
- b) Alignment with the NIF
- c) Data availability at the national level for States and UTs from official statistical systems
- d) The consent of respective Ministries/ Departments
- e) Data ownership, either administrative or survey, by Line Ministries
- f) Sufficient data coverage, such that data for atleast 50 per cent of the States/UTs is available

The NIF, put together by MoSPI, serves as the basis for selection of these indicators. Where State/UT level data is not available for NIF indicators, suitable proxy indicators are identified from official data sources. The NIF indicators for which data was not available at the State/UT level could not be included in the Index.

2. Target setting

The next step is target setting for each indicator, once the required raw data is ready. A suitable target value for 2030 is set for each indicator.

3. Normalisation of raw indicator values

This step involves rescaling each indicator to arrive at normalised scores. The normalisation of indicator values to a standard scale of 0 to 100 (0

denoting the worst performance and 100 denoting target achievement) is required to ensure comparability as different indicators has different ranges of values. Equal weights for each indicator in line with the internationally accepted practices are adopted.

4. Computation of composite Index score

The next step is the computation of composite Index score for every State/UT. The composite score is the arithmetic mean of the Goal score for 16 Goals, for each State/UT, assigning equal weight to each Goal. This score is an indication of the overall position of the States/UTs in their journey towards achieving the SDGs.

What are the takeaways from SDG India Index 3.0?

- ◆ The country's overall SDG score improved by 6 points—from 60 in 2019 to 66 in 2020-21. This indicates that the country overall has progressed forward in its journey towards achieving the SDGs. The positive stride towards achieving the targets is largely driven by exemplary country-wide performance in Goal 6 (Clean Water and Sanitation) and Goal 7 (Affordable and Clean Energy), where the composite Goal scores are 83 and 92, respectively. Seven other Goals drive the positive push—3 (Good Health and



below 50. However, nine States in Goal 2 and 12 States in Goal 5 moved out of the Aspirant category this year as compared to 2019-20.

- ◆ The SDG India Index 3.0 score for the States ranges between 52 and 75; for the

UTs it belongs to the 62 to 79 band. This presents a notable improvement from 2019-20, when the scores varied between 50 and 70 for the States and 59 and 70 for the UTs.

- ◆ Kerala retained its rank as the top State with a score of 75. Chandigarh too maintained its top spot among the UTs with a score of 79.
- ◆ Tamil Nadu and Himachal Pradesh took the second spot while Goa, Uttarakhand, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh shared the fourth spot on the table.

- ◆ When looking at the distribution of the States in terms of the aggregate SDG score across the four classifications, one can observe that no State is a 100 (Achiever) on all 17 goals. While 15 out of the 28 States are in the Front-Runner category and 13 States in the Performer category, among the UTs one falls in the Performer and seven in the Front-Runner categories.
- ◆ While in 2019, ten States/UTs belonged to the category of Front-Runners (score in the range 65-99, including both) twelve more States/UTs find

themselves in this category in 2020-21. Uttarakhand, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Mizoram, Punjab, Haryana, Tripura, Delhi, Lakshadweep, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh graduated to the category of Front-Runners (scores between 65 and 99, including both).

- ◆ Mizoram, Haryana, and Uttarakhand are the top gainers in 2020-21 in terms of improvement in score from 2019-20, with an increase of 12, 10 and 8 points, respectively.

◆ Bihar, Jharkhand and Assam are at the bottom of the Index with a score of 52, 56 and 57, respectively. Among UTs, Dadra and Nagar haveli & Daman and Diu has scored the lowest with a score of 62.

What are SDGs?

The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), also known as the 'Global Goals for Sustainable Development', were adopted by the United Nations in 2015 as a universal call to action to end poverty, protect the planet, and ensure that by 2030 all people enjoy peace and prosperity. As per the United Nations, the SDGs are the "blueprint" to achieve a better and more sustainable future for all. They address the global challenges we face, including poverty, inequality, climate change, environmental degradation, peace and justice.

The 17 SDGs are integrated—they recognize that action in one area will affect outcomes in others, and that development must balance social, economic

and environmental sustainability. These are (in the particular order) No Poverty; Zero Hunger; Good Health and Well-being; Quality Education; Gender Equality; Clean Water and Sanitation; Affordable and Clean Energy; Decent Work and Economic Growth; Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure; Reduced Inequality; Sustainable Cities and Communities; Responsible Consumption and Production; Climate Action; Life Below Water; Life On Land; Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions; and Partnerships to achieve the Goal.

The UN notes that although the word "disability" is not cited directly in all goals, the goals are indeed relevant to ensure the inclusion and development of persons with disabilities.

In India, the SDG Vertical of the NITI Aayog, in collaboration with Union Ministries and States/UTs, is the nodal agency for coordinating and monitoring the Sustainable Development Goals. Through the approach of cooperative and competitive federalism, the Vertical works towards accelerated adoption, implementation, and monitoring of the SDG framework and related initiatives at the national and sub-national levels. The Vertical works closely with key stakeholders—including the Government, civil society, private sector, academia, think tanks, research organisations, and multilateral organisations—to fast-track the achievement of SDGs in the country.

■ PM asserts that tradition and technology will boost initiative of AatmaNirbhar Bharat

He said toys and games combine tradition and technology and the country's capabilities in gaming and toys are continuously increasing. The Prime Minister on June 24 interacted with participants of Toycathon-2021 which was launched to conceptualise innovative toys based on the Indian value system which will inculcate positive behaviour and good value among the children.



■ India reaffirms its commitment towards eliminating educational inequalities at G20

Addressing the virtual G20 Education Ministers meeting in Italy, Minister of State in the Education Ministry, Sanjay Dhotre reiterated the country's commitment towards reducing and eventually eliminating educational poverty, inequalities and early school leaving. Speaking on National Education Policy, 2020, the Minister said it envisages equitable and inclusive education for all, with special focus on children and youth, especially girls, from socially and economically disadvantaged groups who are more at risk of being left behind.

■ India and Fiji sign MoU for cooperation in agriculture and allied sectors field

India and Fiji have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) for cooperation in the field of agriculture and allied sectors. The MoU provides for cooperation in the fields of Dairy Industry, Rice Industry, Root crop diversification, Water Resources Management, Coconut Industry, Food Processing Industry, Agriculture Mechanization, and Horticulture Industry.

■ Tobacco control needs to be pursued like mission & social movement: Harsh Vardhan

Union Minister Dr Harsh Vardhan addressed the virtual event on June 24 to highlight 25 years of Global Tobacco Control Progress and said that tobacco control needs to be pursued like a mission and social movement. He said that India has a dedicated National Tobacco Control Program and targeted actions taken in the last seven years have helped in tobacco control.

■ Railways Ministry says Kisan Rails have given farmers wide access of Indian markets

The Ministry of Railways on June 24 said that introduction of Kisan Rails have given farmers wide access of Indian markets and it has so far carried 2.7 lakh tonnes of consignment. Till now, 60 routes have been operationalised for Kisan Rail. The Ministry also informed that under 'Operation Greens - TOP to Total' scheme of Ministry of Food Processing Industries 50 per cent subsidy in freight is granted on transportation of fruits and vegetables through Kisan Rail trains services. Since the introduction of this scheme, an amount of Rs. 52.38 crore has been disbursed as subsidy.

■ Cabinet approves merger of Central Railside Warehouse Company Ltd with Central Warehousing Corporation

The Union Cabinet has approved the merger and transfer of all assets, liabilities, rights and obligations of Central Railside Warehouse Company Limited (RWC) with Central Warehousing Corporation (CWC). It will unify similar functions of both the companies through a single administration to promote efficiency, optimum capacity utilisation, transparency, accountability, ensure financial savings and leverage railway siding for new warehousing capacities.

INTERNATIONAL

■ Ebrahim Raisi secures landslide victory in Iran's presidential election

Ebrahim Raisi, a hardline cleric and head of the country's judiciary, has been elected as Iran's eighth President. Raisi won 61.95 percent of the votes on a voter turnout of 48.8 percent—the lowest turnout for a presidential election since the 1979 revolution. Raisi will take office in early August, replacing moderate President Hassan Rouhani who was not allowed by the constitution to run for a third consecutive term. Raisi has become the first Iranian President to be sanctioned by the United States over human rights violations. Those included the role that human rights group say Raisi played in the mass execution of political prisoners in 1988 and in the crackdown on the 2009 Green Movement protests.



■ World health, IP, trade bodies launch platform to combat COVID-19 pandemic

The heads of the global health, intellectual property and trade bodies have announced a joint platform to help countries plug the gaps in accessing COVID-19

vaccines, treatments and technologies. World Health Organization (WHO), World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) and World Trade Organization (WTO) said countries would be able to access expertise in places where the three fields cross over in battling the pandemic. According to a joint statement, the platform will provide "a one-stop shop that will make available the full range of expertise on access, intellectual property and trade matters provided by our organisations, and other partners", in a coordinated way.

■ UNESCO: Great Barrier Reef should be listed as 'in danger'

UNESCO has said that the Great Barrier Reef should be put on a list of World Heritage Sites that are "in danger" due to damage caused by climate change. The UN's cultural body said the world's biggest coral reef system should be downgraded to the list and has urged Australia to take accelerated action on global warming. The reef, stretching for 2,300 kilometre off Australia's north-east coast, gained World Heritage status in 1981 for its enormous scientific and intrinsic importance. Scientists say the main reason behind widespread loss of coral is rising sea temperatures as a result of global warming caused by the burning of fossil fuels.

ECONOMY

■ India attracted 38% higher FDI inflow during April 2021 as compared to April 2020

The Ministry of Commerce and Industry has said that India has attracted a total Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) inflow of 6.24 billion US dollars during April 2021 and it is 38 per cent higher as compared to April 2020. The Ministry said, measures taken by the Government on the fronts of FDI policy reforms, investment facilitation and ease of doing business have resulted in increased FDI inflows into the country.

■ FICCI welcomes changes in FAME II scheme

Industry body FICCI has welcomed the recent notification of the Department of Heavy Industry, bringing changes in the Scheme for Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of Electric Vehicles in India Phase II. Sulajja Firodia Motwani of FICCI said that it is expected to accelerate demand for electric vehicles in two wheelers, three wheelers and bus segments and these actions are well aligned with the vision of promoting green mobility for the masses.



■ IFSCA committee to examine global best practices in ship financing & leasing

International Financial Services Centres Authority (IFSCA) has constituted a committee chaired by former Senior Economic Advisor, Vandana Aggarwal, to examine global best practices in ship financing and leasing. This Committee will also identify opportunities and devise a roadmap to enable such activities. India is strategically located on the world's shipping routes and has a large coastline of over 7,500 kilometres.

SPORTS

■ New Zealand beat India by 8 wickets to win WTC title

New Zealand beat India by eight wickets to lift the inaugural World Test Championship title at Southampton. Chasing a victory target of just 139 in 53 overs, the Kiwis finished on 140-2 with more than seven overs left after the match was extended into the reserve sixth day as two days' play was completely washed out. The winning team's captain Kane Williamson slammed an unbeaten knock of 52 runs off 89 balls. Meanwhile, India spinner Ravichandran Ashwin became the leading wicket-taker in the World Test Championship, surpassing Australian fast bowler Pat Cummins by taking his 71st wicket in the WTC final.



■ Manpreet Singh named captain of Men's hockey team for Olympics

Hockey India has named midfielder Manpreet Singh as captain of the 16-member Olympic-bound Men's hockey team. This will be Manpreet's third Olympics. Under Manpreet's captaincy, the Indian team won the Asia Cup in 2017, the Asian Champions Trophy in 2018 and the FIH Series Final in 2019. India will begin their campaign in Tokyo on July 24 when they take on New Zealand in their first Pool stage match.



■ India launches its official Olympic theme song ahead of the Games

India's official Olympic theme song has been launched ahead of the Summer Games in July-August. Playback Singer Mohit Chauhan has composed and sung the song titled 'Lakshya Tera Samne Hai'. Union Minister of Youth Affairs and Sports Kiren Rijiju was present at the launch event organised by the Indian Olympic Association.
